# Course Outline

Improved patient awareness and high predictability of dental implant treatment has seen a significant increase in its uptake and need for general dental practitioners to be aware of basic knowledge in dental implantology as well as upgrade their knowledge and skills in this area of dentistry which is witnessing a fast paced change. The course is aimed at the beginners to ensure knowledge is obtained in a safe learning environment and be able to apply in daily clinical practice.

## Aims and Objectives:

- Obtain an overall perspective of dental Implantology with an evidence based approach.
- Gain necessary surgical and restorative skill set to implement simple treatment plans.
- Understand the challenges involved in surgical and prosthetic phase of treatment.
- Refer appropriately based on skill levels.

## Outcomes:

On completion of the course, participants should be able to:

1. Diagnose and carry out treatment planning for patients requiring dental implant based treatment.
2. Candidates will be able to carry out initial risk assessment and consent patient appropriately.
3. Insert and restore dental implants under supervision in a simulated environment.
4. Candidates will be able to identify complexity of individual cases and place dental implants in simple cases under supervision as well as refer for additional support and guidance based on treatment need and skill sets.
5. Describe the challenges presented in the surgical and prosthetic phase of treatment.

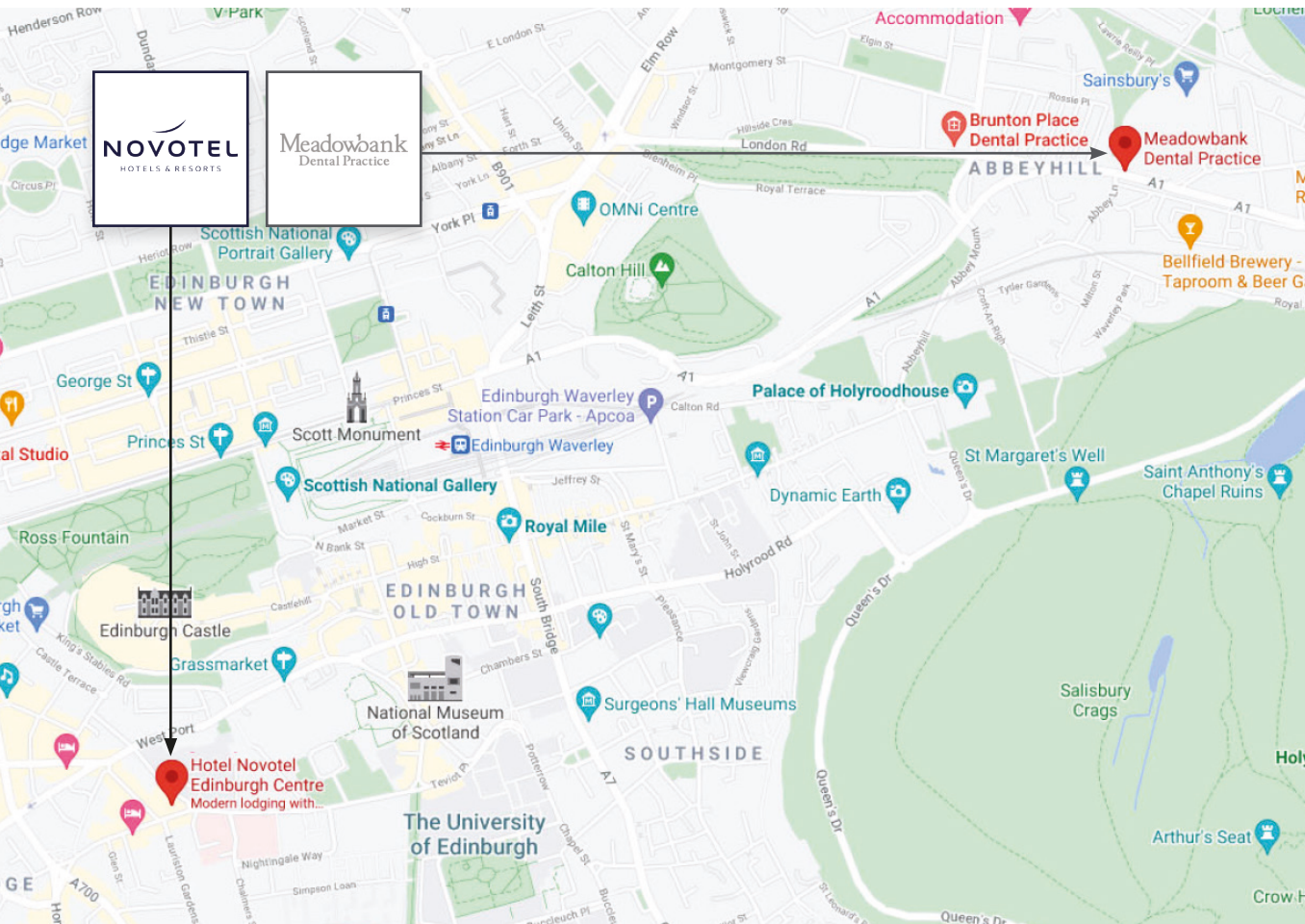
